






- New Production Process Flow (Lean Six Sigma Management)

THE SITUATION IN BRUNEI DARUSSALAM



(Home to Print Plus Sdn Bhd)

- The first COVID-19 case in BRUNEI was reported on 9th March 2020, when its first case was confirmed in Tutong District.
- The Pandemic that time had spread to other district of BRUNEI, except for Temburong District.
- The Pandemic peak spread in BRUNEI was on 27th March 2020 reaching up to 115 cases.
- Stabilised as it slowed down on April & May 2020 as public restaurant, schools, public area and events are closed/ canceled.



CHALLENGES IN THE PRINTING INDUSTRY



- Due to COVID-19, many events has been cancelled.
- Demand and printing of national event materials are on hold/ canceled.
- The government has introduced the de-escalation plan allowing national events to be reintroduced to the public
 - Orders are slowly coming back to the company.
 - Implementing uplifting phases of restriction are in motion



TRENDS AND CHALLENGES CHALLENGES IN THE PRINTING INDUSTRY



- Preventive maintenance was a challenge as maintenance team done by overseas company to come in Brunei was hard, as they need to go for 14days quarantine.
- Transport and commissioning of new machines was a challenge
- Training for the development of management and staff are done all in house.
- Graphic design services was pushed because of the rise of food delivery services (Runners)
