## Course Objective

This unit will define the critical thinking mindset, demonstrate problem solving skills and enhance creative thinking skills.

- ◆ **Demonstrate problem solving skills within own scope of work**
  - Defining problem & approach used in problem separation
  - Explain methods to apply logical inquiry to issues
- ◆ **Analyze and report business issues and make recommendations to relevant stakeholders**
  - Describe methods used in analysing business issues & process of applying force field analysis
- ◆ **Enhance creative thinking skills among team members**
  - Define creative thinking & describing types of creative person
  - Enhancing creative thinking skills among team members
  - Describe the challenges of being creative

*\*SMEs are defined as companies with*  
(i) *at least 30% local shareholding; AND*  
(ii) *Group annual sales turnover of not more than \$100 million OR Group employment size of not more than 200 employees.*

### Workfare Training Support Scheme:

Singapore Citizens aged ≥ 35 years & earning ≤ \$2,000/month are eligible for 95% course fee subsidy. Companies can also apply for absentee payroll at 95% of hourly basic salary.

### Funding Eligibility

In order to enjoy the funding, participants need to fulfill the following requirements:

1. Singapore Citizens or Permanent Residents (PR) of Singapore
2. Attain at least 75% course attendance
3. Successfully complete assessment & certified as competent
4. Participant has not enjoyed funding for the same course before
5. For company-sponsored participants, training is fully sponsored by companies, which are registered or incorporated in Singapore
